Activity -National Seminar

Theme – Women Empowerment: Pain Behind the Veils

Date: 17/03/2023

Venue: Auditorium

Shah Stanam Ji College of Education, Sirsa organized a one day national seminar on the theme **“Women Empowerment: Pain Behind the Veils”** under the aegis of Women Cell. The major objective of this seminar was to analyze the myth versus reality of women empowerment. Moreover, this seminar also focused on identifying the road blocks in the way of women empowerment and suggesting remedial measures. This programme was hosted by Dr. Meenakshi (Associate Prof.), who was coordinator of this programme. The inaugural session of the seminar was marked by the welcome of the guests, lightening of the lamp and Sarsawati Vandana. After Saraswati Vandana, Swati (B.Ed. Second Year) and Dimple (D.El.Ed. Second Year) presented a welcome dance in the honor of worthy guests of the seminar.

After this Dr. Rajni Bala (Principal) the convener of this programme, gave welcome speech and thanked all the guests for gracing this occasion with their worthy presence. After this Dr. Dipti Garg (IPS Sirsa) Chief Guest of this programme expressed her view about women empowerment. She said that

everyone should come forward for women empowerment and create a safe environment for women. Moreover, she also said women empowerment is a very comprehensive task. She also put forward some examples of women's role in drug eradication. Apart from this, she had an interactive session with other participants and students, who were present at this seminar. She also gave some tips to the students regarding preparation of UPSC examination. At the end of her speech, she motivated the students to have strength to overcome the depression and failures in life.

After this, Prof. Ranjit Kaur (Chairperson, Dept. of Education, CDLU, Sirsa) Resource Person of this programme expressed her ideas regarding the patriarchal structure of Indian Society. She threw light on transitional stages of women empowerment through various policies and programmes introduced by governments at national and international level. Apart from this, she told about the role of women in economy. She said that economically empowered woman can empower many other women. Though the condition of women has improved, but still the cases of domestic violence and criminal cases against women have increased in many states of India.

Dr. Navdeep Kaur (Assistant Professor), Resource person of the seminar threw light on definition of women empowerment. She said that women have lots of pain and sufferings behind their veils. A woman behind the veil is invisible, unseen

and unheard. It disconnects her from the other world. She emphasized on the need of financial literacy of women. She said that women should not transfer their power to others, which have been given to them by outer agencies. Woman should be aware of their priorities. At last, she said that women should be proactive instead of being reactive.

Prof. Arti Gaur (Dean of Colleges, CDLU, Sirsa) Guest of Honour expressed her views on reality of women empowerment. She focused on the need of realization of women empowerment. A woman must always feel empowered from within. Moreover, she also said that we should focus on abolition of female feticide, which is still prevalent in this modern society. She said that we should focus on gender equality, which will help in formation of an ideal society.

Dr. Charanpreet Kaur (Administrator), patron of the seminar, expressed her thoughts regarding reality of women empowerment. She also paid tribute to Late Dr. T.N. Chugh Ji.
